On 27 February 2022, following the Russian large-scale attack against Ukraine, Chancellor Scholz declared the Zeitenwende in German security policy. How can we assess its implementation? In Germany, the transformation of the Bundeswehr, the restart of massive arms production, and indeed, the change of the general mindset still remain to be a huge task. The European dimension of the Zeitenwende is still unclear and the US presidential election 2024 may change basic fundamentals of German and European security. Should Germany turn its Zeitenwende into a European project?

PD Dr. habil. Markus Kaim is a Senior Fellow of the International Security Research Division of the Stiftung Wissenschaft und Politik (German Institute for Security and International Affairs), the leading German policy-oriented research institute, and was the Head of that Division 2008-2015. He conducted research and taught at a number of prestigious institutes and universities in Germany, US and Canada. His major research areas are German Defence and Security Policy, Transatlantic Security Relationship/NATO, Defence and Security Policy of selected NATO partners as well as the United Nations and Conflict Resolution. Markus Kaim contributed to the drafting of the first ever German National Security Strategy (2023).
