- Institutional change in grant economic checking (*účetní střediska*) – not working on personal computers unless you organize the “Remote Access” (*vzdálený přístup*);
- If planning to apply for GAUK, PRIMUS, UNCE or any other project, which are internal CUNI, and any EU project make sure that you start your application earlier than deadline, because the research project office is not able to deal with the applications, which are too close to the deadline effectively and assist you sufficiently. Also, you have to submit a project to the director, who has to provide each project with an IMS confirmation.
- Mobility Fund (*Fond mobility*)
 - o for students to travel on bilateral agreements to countries beyond Erasmus
 - o NEW: for researchers (research stays abroad)
